

Nova Scotians are struggling to pay the rising costs of rent, and the situation is getting worse. Twenty percent of households in Nova Scotia spend more than 50 percent of their income on rent and utilities.



With vacancy rates as low as 1.6 per cent, landlords are in a position to endlessly raise rents.

People are regularly reporting rent increases in the hundreds of dollars, forcing them from their homes so their landlord can turn the unit into a short-term rental or find a tenant who can pay more. Rent control existed in Nova Scotia until 1993, when it was quietly removed by the Liberals.
