

People's Park media policy:

We appreciate media and community attention focused on amplifying the values of permanent, accessible, dignified, and safer housing for all unhoused people, including those living here at People's Park.

It is vital, however, for this attention to also be accompanied with a clear ethic of consent for all photos, videos and audio recordings that may be taken in this space, particularly with those that have been harmed and been made vulnerable by unwanted surveillance, criminalization, harassment and violence.

To this end, media members must stick to the following principles when visiting People's Park:

- Please present your media credentials when you arrive at the space.
- Please contact the media liaison before speaking with, recording, or photographing any People's Park residents, volunteers and/or the space – the name of the on-call media liaison will be available to you.
- Please make sure you ask for the enthusiastic and ongoing consent of any People's Park resident and/or volunteer who agrees to speak with you, be photographed or be recorded.
- Please be sure to send a copy of any article/recording/photographs you do take (via your publication) to @PADScommunity on Twitter

All other community members should also ask for consent from People's Park residents and volunteers to post any photographs, videos or audio recordings they take within the space.
